In the next two terms the forest starts to bloom and we can use its fruits to make things to eat and drink. We only use easily identifiable ingredients such as blackberry, nettle, sticky weed and hawthorn (this is not an inclusive list) to make juices, fritters and pesto.

If you have any concerns about your child taking part in wild and foraged food activities please let us know. We will obviously only doing this in a COVID secure way. The children will be able to use the tools as usual and these will be cleaned between sessions.

The weather is likely to be getting colder, so here is a reminder of the winter clothing kit. It is muddy at forest school so old/outdoor play clothes are suggested. Please send your child to school on the day in their forest school kit, which they will wear all day. If your child doesn't come in to school in their forest school kit they will be taken up in either their PE kit or school uniform whichever is more appropriate to the weather. (Please do not send them in football strips as they aren't suitable as they do not provide adequate warmth).
