# Reading

- \* This year, more than ever reading is so important.
- \* Please listen to your child (even if they are fluent) every night and record it in their record book. We will be using these everyday so they must be in school daily.
- \* Children will be read with 1:1 with an adult this term to assess their reading level and check their fluency and comprehension of what they have read.
- \* On a Wednesday evening please sign your Buster Book club bookmark with a record of how many minutes your child has read for. This is important as we have a weekly competition to see which class reads the most. We have won some fantastic prizes from the KM Charities team in the past as we have read the most in Kent! I wonder who will win?
- \* Try to encourage your child to read a variety of texts to help broaden their knowledge and experiences.

### Homework

Homework will be sent out on a **Thursday** and due in on the following **Tuesday**.

This will include one piece of English and one piece of maths per week. This is to be done in pencil in your purple homework book.

In addition we ask you regularly use TT Rockstars to support your multiplication tables and that you read daily.

Mrs Corner might give you some special topic homework which will help you with your work in class!

#### PE

- \* PE lessons are on a **Wednesday and Friday.** 
  - \* We will be going outside for both sessions so the children must dress accordingly.
- \* Outdoor Games Trainers (which might get muddy), PE t-shirt, shorts, jumper, jogging trousers.
- \* Please try to make sure your child has their kit in school at all times. Earrings must be taken out and long hair tied back.

#### Assessment

- \* Ongoing informal assessments during the year for reading, writing and maths. We will assess where the children are with their learning journey and prepare and deliver support for children who need catch up and challenging.
- \* We assess the children regularly and also conduct Pupil Progress Meetings three times a year to ensure your child is on track to meet their targets.
- \* If you have any concerns about your child and their progress, please make an appointment to see the class teacher / Mrs S Davies (SENCO)

## Online Safety

- \* Many Lunsford children regularly use the internet and social media and we have a duty to help them keep safe online.
- \* Users should be sixteen to use Whatsapp and thirteen to use Instagram, Snapchat, Twitter, Facebook, Skype and TikTok.
- \* Fortnite Battle Royale says users should be twelve + to play
- \* Although there is no age restriction for watching Youtube videos, users need to be thirteen to have their own Youtube account enabling them to subscribe to channels, like videos, post comments and add videos.
