

features	A part of the face such as the eyes, nose, or chin.	
senses	Any of five ways to understand or experience your surroundings. The senses are touch, smell, taste, sight, and hearing.	
texture	The feel or look of a surface.	
mammal	A warm-blooded animal with fur or hair on its skin and a skeleton.

Humans have five senses. The senses are linked to parts of the body.

Sense	Part of the body
sight	eyes
smell	nose
touch	hands, feet, etc.
hearing	ears
taste	tongue
