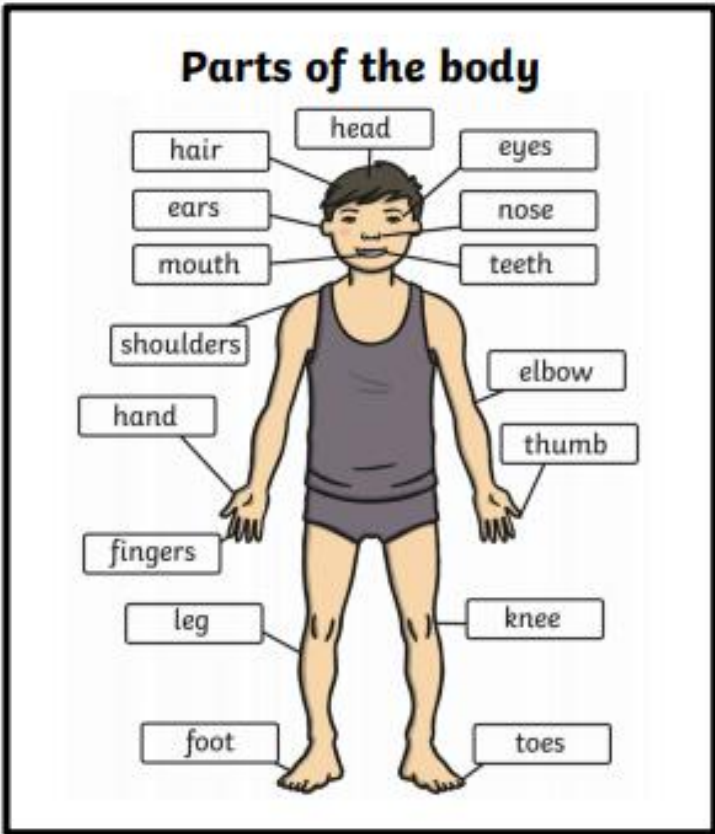
Miller Hutchinson – Engineer who invented the first hearing aid in 1898

Key Vocabulary

human	A person; human being. Humans are part of the animal group called mammals
body	The main part of a person or animal, not including the head, arms, and legs.
features	A part of the face such as the eyes, nose, or chin.
senses	Any of five ways to understand or experience your surroundings. The senses are touch, smell, taste, sight, and hearing.
texture	The feel or look of a surface.
mammal	A warm-blooded animal with fur or hair on its skin and a skeleton.

Sense	Part of the body
sight	eyes
smell	nose
touch	hands, feet, etc.
hearing	ears
taste	tongue

A carnivore is an animal that eats other animals . Here are some examples: wolf snake lion crocodile tiger penguin	A herbivore is an animal that eats plants . Here are some examples: cow sheep rabbit horse deer gorilla	An omnivore is an animal that eats both plants and other animals . Here are some examples: pig hedgehog fox bear sloth mouse
