Tuesday

Phonics (approx. 30 mins daily)

inside	envelopes	shine	those	smile


Now try and play the following game, select either i_e or o_e to practice this sound. (Phonics Bllom > Phase 5 Phonics Frog)

English (approx. 50 mins daily)

Using the notes and sheets from yesterday sequence the life cycle of an Emperor Penguin. You might want to print the life cycle sheet out or draw your own using the pictures on the sheet to help you, this is completely up to you.

Once you have draw your life cycle write at least 1/2 sentences about each picture. Eg. The baby penguin is grey and fluffy. The baby penguin hides on it's Daddy's feet.
