Monday

Phonics (approx. 30 mins daily)

Use the Sound Card video to revise our phoincs sounds and their rhymes (eg. ow – brown cow).

We are going to start learning about the different sounds one letter can make. Today's focus is the letter "i" which can make the "i" sound and the "igh" sound.

Have a go at reading the following words – remember the "i" might not make the same sound that we are use to.

Now ask someone to read the next words to you and try and write them down.

Now try and put some of these words into a sentence.

This term we will be focussing on our Dance Topic, I have included the link below.



Practice reading the following sentences using what you have learnt about the "i" grapheme.

Read through Miss Wickison's writing about the chick! Can you spot what I have missed?

Go through Miss Wickison's writing and correct her captial letters and full stops (she even forgets to use her phonics sometimes!). Can you help her fix her writing?

Once you have done this read back through your work from yesterday. Check that your words are spelt correctly and that you have capital letters and full stops in the correct places.

Finally try and add 2 more sentences to your writing.

PSHE (approx. 1 hour)



Wednesday

Phonics (approx. 30 mins daily)

This week we are learning about how a letter/grapheme can make more than 1 sound. Today we are learning about the "o" letter which makes an "o" sound and an "oh" sound.

Read the following words:

Now ask someone to read the next words to you and try and write them down.

Now try and put some of these words into a sentence.

English (approx. 50 mins daily)

Over the next 3 lessons we are going to create Information Texts about Penguins!

Watch the videos of Miss Wickison reading our books talk to someone at home about what you have learnt.

Then look at Miss Wickison's modelled write (example). This has got lots of information that you might want to magpie, it is also laid out in sections.

Non-Fiction (Fact texts) are often laid out like this so that the reader can find information that they are interested in or need. This about all of the facts that you have learnt about Penguins, what do you think people would like to know?

Think of 2/3 "Did you know?" facts that you could include in your Information Text/Fact File.

Today you need practice the first 10 words on the list of 10 (written below). Lots of these words you will know already so I have added a challenge at the end.

There are lots of ways that you can practice your spellings – practice tests, learning rhymes, practice writing them in your favourite colours. It is up to you.

Finish off your phonics with a quick spelling test. Ask someone to read the words above and try to write them accurately without support. Post the photo of your marked spelling test on Dojo. Don't forget that getting things wrong is the best way to learn so don't worry if you don't get them all right.
