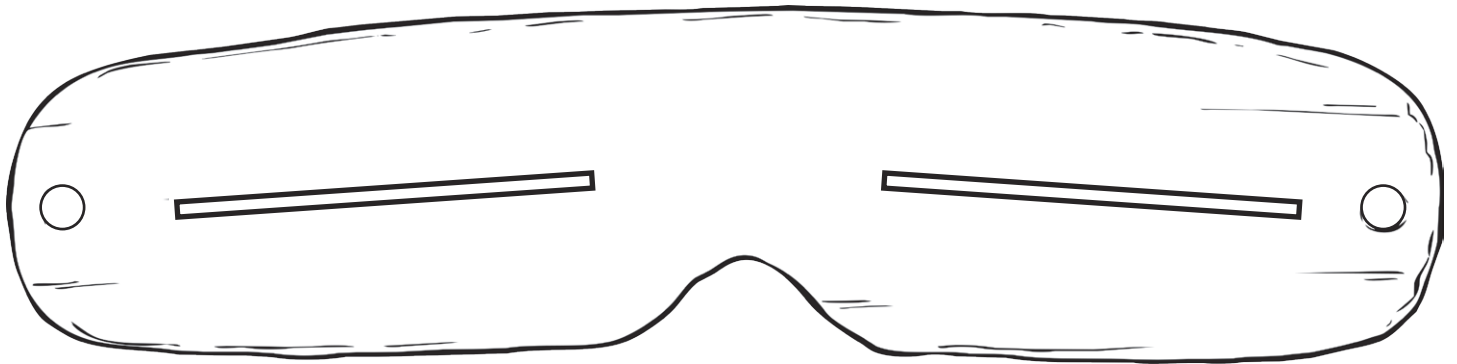


Inuit Snow Goggles

Instructions

Decorate and cut out the snow goggles below. Attach string to the sides to secure to your face and try them on outside in the winter. Do they make it easier to see?



The Inuit use snow goggles to help them see in winter and spring months because they prevent snow blindness. Snow blindness happens when there is a lot of snow or white ice on the ground and it reflects the Sun's rays. This can cause painful damage to the eyes and temporary blindness. They were traditionally made of wood or caribou antler. They are fitted to the face with light from the outside only entering through slits.
