Planting a Vegetable Garden

This weekend Fleur is helping Granddad plant a vegetable garden. Granddad's garden gets lots of sun and has good soil. Fleur waters the garden in the morning before the day gets too hot. Then Granddad gets the soil ready for planting. He turns the soil over with a shovel and mixes in compost. Then he rakes the soil so it is smooth and ready to make his planting rows. Fleur weeds the edges of the vegetable garden.

Granddad and Fleur have made a list of the vegetables they will plant. Together they plant seedling rows of tomatoes, lettuces and cucumbers. Next to the



rows they plant a border of herbs, like basil and thyme. It will be Fleur's job to water the young plants each day. Granddad's job will be to check for snails!
