
White Rose Maths Home Learning

In this very uncertain climate, the White Rose Maths website - one we access at school when planning lessons - has produced a series of daily maths lessons for each year group from Reception to Year 6 as a home learning activity. For each year group, there is a teaching video to watch with your child: this can be stopped regularly to discuss any questions posed within the video. Children can then complete the questions for 30 minutes; there are also answers available if required.

The resources are being updated weekly and we would suggest starting at week 1, as a lot of the videos link on from one another.

Step by step guide:

1) Log onto www.whiterose.com/homelearning and click on the relevant year group:



2) Watch the video together before your child attempts to work through the accompanying resources (Get the Activity/ Get the Answers downloads). These are resources that your child will be familiar with from maths lessons at school:



If you feel that the scheme of work for your children's year group is not stretching them enough or is too difficult, you can access either the year above or below.
