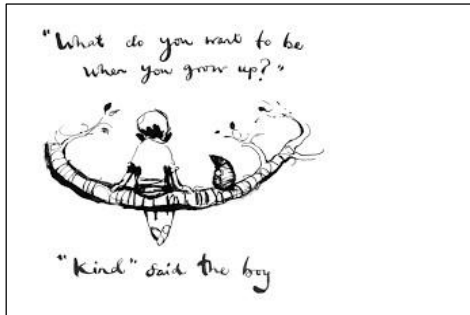

English:

11am Zoom – World Book Day! We will continue to read 'The Boy, The Mole, The Fox and the Horse'.

The boy, the mole, the fox and the horse are four friends who share a deep, unshakeable bond. Through a series of brief but profound conversations, Mackesy teases universal truths and rich wisdom from the mouths of his characters, celebrating warmth and empathy. Today and tomorrow we're going to recreate a page, using George Mackesy's characters. Today, we'll need to think of our own inspirational quote, saying or message. You may need to discuss this with an adult at home.





Task: (today we will plan our page!)

1. Have a think about a message / saying that means a lot to you. Perhaps it could be one someone special says to you – you may need to talk to an adult about this!
2. As a draft, try different ways of writing it out as beautifully as you can. What sort of handwriting will you use and how will you set it out?
3. You must use the characters from our book. Work out who is saying the quote and who replies.
4. Work out layout for your page – draft / jot out your ideas. **Tomorrow, we will create our pages.**
