## **English:**

LO: To use possessive apostrophes (singular).

This will be on Zoom – but can be completed without attending – watch this instead:

How to use possessive apostrophes - BBC Bitesize (we only need the singular possessive apostrophe today!!!)

An apostrophe can be used to show omission (leaving out) of a letter(s), for instance in 'CONTRACTIONS'

```
i.e. cannot = can't
    will not = won't
    it is = it's
```

Today we'll be revising possessive apostrophes. The addition of an apostrophe and an 's' shows possession – i.e. who a noun belongs to. We are looking at singular possession today – i.e. when it belongs to one person / noun.

For example,

the toy belonged to the cat = the cat's toy
the bike belonged to the girl = the girl's bike

<u>Task:</u> Have a go at the attached worksheet <u>on a piece of lined paper / in your book</u>, task A, B and C. Extension = write 3 sentences of your own that need a possessive apostrophe (singular). Write out your work into your book, under the heading:

## **English:**

LO: To use possessive apostrophes (singular and plural).

This will be on Zoom – but can be completed without attending – watch this instead:

How to use possessive apostrophes - BBC Bitesize

If the possessive apostrophe belongs to more than one person / thing, the person / thing needs to be a plural first, then an apostrophe goes at the end (you don't need another 's'!)

The toy belonging to one cat is – the cat's toy

The toy belonging to more than one cat – the cats' toy

You can't *hear* the difference – you can only see when it is written down.

NB - Irregular plural, e.g. children, people, men, women etc., which don't have an 's' still need an apostrophe and an 's' – e.g. the children's toys (more than one child)

<u>Task 1:</u> Complete the worksheet, saying whether the possessive apostrophe is referring to ONE owner or TWO or more owners – i.e. singular or plural

<u>Task 2:</u> On a piece of lined paper, write 3 sentences for singular possession and 3 with plural possession:

**singular possession** e.g. The dog's ball rolled under the sofa. **AND plural possession** e.g. The monkeys' bananas were not ripe enough.

Task 3: Irregular plural possession

# RE:

#### What would Jesus do? Can we live by the values of Jesus in the 21st century?

Today's lesson is about forgiveness.

Jesus often told 'parables' to his followers and disciples. These parables are simple stories that have a moral or message in them – in this case, about the importance of forgiveness.

In the Parable of the Two Debtors, Luke 7:36–50, Jesus teaches that we all need forgiveness, but those of us who need it most may be the most grateful! In the Parable of the Unforgiving Servant, Matthew 18:21–35, Jesus teaches that a thankful response to God's generous forgiveness is to forgive others who do wrong to us.
