This includes black school shoes; trainers are not permitted unless in exceptional circumstances following a discussion with either myself or Mrs Lomax. Hair should be a natural colour and tied up if longer than collar length. Any hair accessories should be discreet, not brightly coloured and jewellery should not be worn with the exception of small studded earrings which should be removed for PE lessons. Thank you for your help and support in reinforcing these regulations with your children
